Many parishioners & especially those with families will have all sorts to think about these days, not least their own economy. Do make sure you look after your loved ones at this time. With respect to your offering, please consider your church offering only as part of ALL your outgoings at this time.

<u>The Right to Life</u>: The right to gather peacefully and offer help to pregnant women approaching an abortion clinic is under attack. Various pro-life charities are seeking to ensure that those who seek to offer an alternative to the termination of pregnancy can be heard. More details on the newsletter on the website. Whilst the whole situation with respect to pregnancy and abortion needs to be handled with love and sensitivity, you may wish to get involved.

The right to gather peacefully and offer help to pregnant women approaching an abortion clinic is under attack again. Two MPs are currently bringing forward bills to introduce buffer zones around abortion facilities to ban peaceful pro-life vigils.

On 24 June 2020, a huge majority (213 - 47) of MPs voted in favour of Dr Rupa Huq MP's Ten-Minute Rule Bill "to restrict demonstrations in the vicinity of abortion clinics". This Bill comes up for second reading in the House of Commons on **25 September**. Sarah Olney MP is also introducing a similar bill on **30 October**. Neither bill is likely to move forward at this time. However, it shows that the abortion lobby is determined to keep pushing to ban prolifers from offering crucial last minute help to women in need.

We must make our voices heard and SAVE THE RIGHT TO SAVE LIVES

- The offer of help from a caring pro-life person is a lifeline for many women, who feel abortion is their only choice.
