At each Mass we pray for all the parish.

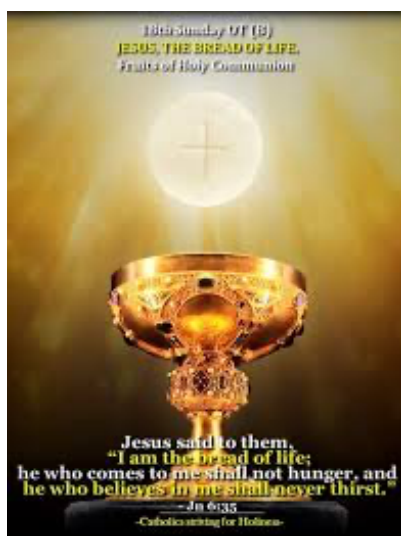
