**Helping Refugees:** Recently the parish received an email from Tim Shepley who is involved in Reset Communities and Refugees which is associated by N4N and supported by the NHS. N4N is a complementary pathway for admission to the UK, offering a place of safety for those who need it who cannot access these through other routes.

Tim writes: We're keen to find volunteers and I'm hoping that you can point me in the right direction. We are launching a new pilot programme for community volunteers to welcome refugees to their neighbourhood in Dewsbury. It is called Neighbours for Newcomers, N4N. Newcomers will be nurses who will be moving to work in the NHS. Nurses will be arriving in Sept/October and living and working at the hospital in Dewsbury.
