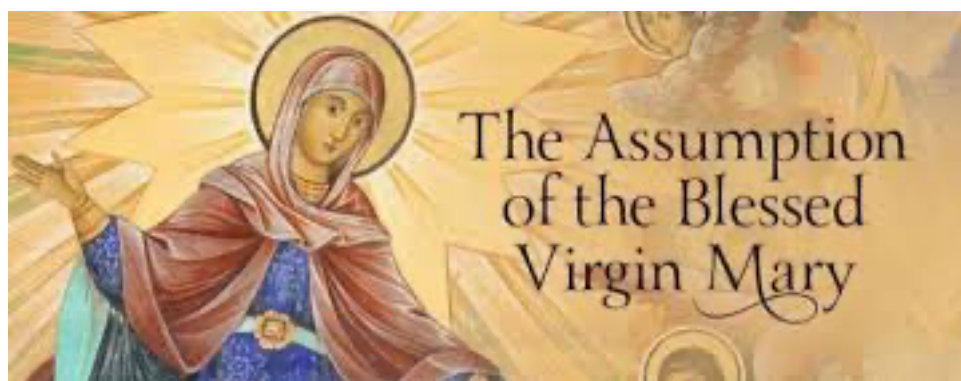

St. Joseph's Roof lights Update: The intended work has been approved by the Diocese. It involves several contractors. They are now being co-ordinated so that, hopefully, work can start in September. The new roof lights will be double-glazed and in a similar colour to the existing, but the glass will be significantly stronger. It is expected that installation work could take a week (or more depending on the weather). Consequently, it might be necessary to close the church for that week, but this will be reviewed nearer to the start of work. In preparation, the old playground behind the church has been completely cleared.
