Pope Leo's Coat of Arms:



The Holy See Press Office released the official explanation of Pope Leo XIV's coat of arms on Wednesday. In the explanation, Fr. Antonio Pompili. Vice President of the Italian Heraldic-Genealogical Institute, highlights its Marian and Augustinian elements.

The Pope's coat of arms includes the traditional papal symbols of the crossed keys of St. Peter and episcopal mitre.
